### **BISHOP'S EPISTLE**

## Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ!

As I am writing, we are presently in the midst of Whitsuntide (Pentecost), one the three highest and holiest seasons of the Christian Year. Each year we complete the drama of our redemption as told through the Church Calendar as we reach this final chapter before entering the Trinity Season. The three seasons, Christmas, Easter, and Whitsuntide, are the traditional times in which members of the APA are expected to receive Holy Communion. The canon law of the Church mandates that communicants must receive Holy Communion at least three times in the year, one time being Easter. The other two times to receive should be Christmas and Whitsuntide. The other festivals of the Church year commemorate the Mission of our Lord, His birth, manifestation, crucifixion resurrection, and Ascension, Pentecost concerns the Mission of the Church, by which our Lord, Jesus Christ is perpetuated in all time and extended throughout the world. Jesus spent his entire ministry in a narrow strip of land on the Mediterranean Sea ministering and teaching his disciples in preparation for their Gospel mission to the whole world. Whitsunday is therefore the birthday of the Church, on which the life of the Holy Spirit was given to the disciples empowering them and their successors to carry that Mission into the present age. We see how He came and what His role is for the Church. He came as a mighty rushing wind, the breath of God, and a gift as of fire which would warm the cold heart, and lighten men's darkness, soften men's hardness, and kindle the dead matter of the world into heavenly flame. The message to all gathered that day was that in the One, Holy Catholic Church, there should be neither Jew nor Greek, bond nor free. The Gospel is for all mankind: It tells of a universal need, and universal grace and of the perpetual expansion and adaptation of the one body of Christ for all races, times, and for all needs. The Holy Spirit came as a fire to impart to the disciples both the light of truth in their mental and spiritual darkness, and also the warmth of holy affections that we would love one another as we are loved by our Lord. It was the self-same gift that brought truth to the mind and love to the heart.

With that said, I want to encourage everyone who is possibly able to plan to be at this year's Synod at St. Barnabas' Church in Dunwoody (Atlanta). Georgia. It is critical at this time of transition that we show our support for our new Ordinary of the DEUS, Bishop Chad Jones and the new Presiding Bishop and his ministry. It is also important that we give our best wishes and thanks to those who will be retiring or resigning from their ministries in our beloved church. This is of course the retirement year for your Presiding and Diocesan Bishop. But, there are other important people in the life of our church who will be retiring from their office, Provincial DEUS Treasurer. D.J. Fulton. Chancellor for the Province and DEUS, Glen Wieland, I personally appreciate, and I feel I speak for everyone, the hard work, dedication, and expertise they brought to these critical roles. We know it will be difficult to replace them. This is also a special time in that we have not had an in-person Synod in two years and an APA Synod in four. Let's make every effort to come together with our fellow members from our DEUS, DMA. and DOW and with thankful hearts celebrate a true reunion.

#### A Monumental Synod

This will be the 10<sup>th</sup> Synod of the APA. The DMA met via Zoom in 2020, but the DEUS only handled critical Synod business through their Standing Committee, and the DOW Synod was postponed until this year 2021 due to pandemic closures. The critical measure for the APA will be the ratification by the Provincial Synod of the new presiding bishop of the APA following his election by the APA/House of Bishops. This will be a monumental year, so please do not miss it.

#### Lenten Appeal

St. James' Church will be the recipient of the Lenten Appeal Funds. As a final word of encouragement for those who have not contributed to the Lenten Appeal and wish to do so. I have, along with the enthusiastic approval of St. James' Church Mission Committee, assigned Father Kevin Fife to serve as Vicar. I would like to include a quote from Father Fife about his assignment which will begin August 1, 2021.

"As soon as you see St. James, it becomes clear why it was chosen for this year's Lenten Appeal. It is a place ripe with potential that immediately inspires you to work and dream for its future. The land has been dedicated to God, and especially the Anglican tradition, since the 1700s. This is a very rare and gloriously old history to have in America. And these centuries of history bring with them a gravitas and ethos of devotion passed down. That we own such a place should be a deep source of pride for the APA. This is an immense gift given to us to steward and use for the glory of God! There is nothing else like it. To reclaim such an old place for the traditional faith and enable it to become a thriving, vibrant, and healthy parish is our duty."

#### DMA and DOW to merge into a new Diocese

The DMA and DOW are completing the work to create a new and unified Diocese that will be the presence of the APA west of the Mississippi River to the Pacific Coast and south to the border of Mexico. We are thankful for the leadership of the Rt. Rev. Robert T. Giffin, D.D., Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of Mid-America and Canon Robert Hawkins, Vicar General of the Diocese of the West.

The process is now being finalized, including the collating and merging of the Canons of both Dioceses, arranging for an expanded and merged Standing Committee and Board of Examining Chaplains, as well as gathering ideas about how such a large geographic Diocese would function and sustain its viability and presence.

The plan is that this unification effort will be ratified by both Dioceses at their upcoming 2021 Synods, to be held in Dunwoody, Georgia. After ratification, the proposed merger of the Dioceses

as a new entity (likely called the "Diocese of the Central and Western States") will be submitted to the Provincial Synod to be ratified. Following this acceptance, God willing, the new Diocese will convene after Provincial Synod and elect its new Standing Committee, etc., and develop a new website as well as other social media pages.

Please pray for this effort of unity in the APA, as it will not only aid in the mission for this large geography, but also pool resources and ministries that will better assist us to expand and grow while working with our fellow G4 jurisdictions.
